Birth Control	• Prescription • Dispensing at low cost (pills, patch, Depo, emergency contraception-Plan B, Ella) • IUD & contraceptive implant referrals • Administration of Depo • IUD removals • Counselling/education
Pregnancy	• Testing and counselling • Prenatal Care referrals for client without a primary care provider • Referrals for pregnancy options (termination, adoption)
Sexually Transmitted and Blood Borne Infections	• Testing for Chlamydia, Gonorrhea, Trichomonas, and Herpes • Assessment and treatment for HPV (genital warts) • Syphilis, Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B and Hepatitis C testing • HIV testing (including ANONYMOUS & RAPID testing) • Treatment of infections/Referrals as needed Testing Methods • Individualized testing based on exposure site which can include urine samples, blood samples, and/or swabs (oral, vaginal, anal, penile)
Cervical Screening (pap)	• Cervical Screening offered to individuals who meet the eligibility criteria and who do NOT have a primary care provider and/or their primary care provider does NOT provide screening
Vaccines	• Vaccination based on eligibility for priority populations (HPV, Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B, Mpox)
Prevention	• Free external and internal condoms • Free flavored condoms • Free dental dams • Free water based & silicone lubricants

* Most of the clinics are led by nurses. Some clients may be redirected for further assessment by a physician if no physician is available.
